



Foster Care Program

Not having a place called home is an important factor to a child's development. Children in foster care can have an array of support depending on their foster family, location and organization working with them. Celebrations give families the opportunity to spend focused and individualized attention on a child and works to build self esteem and security.



How it works:

- Questionnaire is filled out to find the interests of the child
- Date and Time are set
- MOSAIC volunteer arrives with supplies
- Celebration consists of games, gift opening, cake eating and community outing with staff or parent
- Parties can last for a few hours and can celebrate any minor holiday or achievement in the child's life

- Services are free
- Individualized to each child
- Adults assist child in creation of celebration
- Activities can take place in the home or in the community
