Senior citizens are often considered one of the most isolated and forgotten populations of the community. Due to health problems, distant or deceased family members, senior citizens are often placed in nursing homes, assisted living communities or live alone in their homes. The goal of MOSAIC's Senior Program is to connect these seniors with a volunteer to celebrate important occasions with them.



How it works:

- Questionnaire is filled out to find the interests of the senior
- Date and Time are set
- MOSAIC volunteer arrives with supplies
- Celebration consists of gift opening, cake eating, personalized activities or community outing with staff
- Parties can last for a few hours and can celebrate any minor holiday or achievement in the individual's life

- Services are free
- Individualized to each senior
- Volunteers assist seniors in the creation of the celebration
- Activities can take place in the home or in the community
